## **IRVINE JUNIOR GAMES EVENTS**

4th, 5th and 6th grades may select one sprint, one distance and one field event. Sprint events are limited. Runoffs to determine the entrants in these events will be conducted at your child's school. Other events are open to any IUSD student in 4th-8th grade. No Eliminations.

**RELAYS** for all grades will be run by gender and grade with 4 girls and 4 boys from each grade per school. Individual schools will determine the entrants for this event.

#### 4th GRADE

**SPRINT** 50 *or* 100 meter **DISTANCE** 400 meter run

Soccer kick or bag shot or standing long

jump **or** basketball shot

### 5th & 6th GRADE

**SPRINT** 50 *or* 100 meter **DISTANCE** 400 *or* 800 meter run

**FIELD** Soccer kick *or* bag shot *or* standing long

jump **or** basketball shot

#### 7th & 8th GRADE

7th and 8th graders may sign up to participate in *all* sprint, distance and 2 field events as listed below.

**SPRINT** 100 meter sprint

**DISTANCE** 400, 800 *and/or* 1,500 meter run Soccer kick, running long jump, *and/or* 

basketball shot (limit 2)
