This marks the 35th year where athletes, sponsors, and dignitaries will come together for the Opening Ceremony, which kicks off with the athlete parade and the lighting of the 2024 flame. As ICF looks forward to celebrating this Irvine tradition, the Irvine Junior Games promise to continue its unsurpassed role as the premier Irvine family fundraising track and field event with participation by $1,300 \, 4^{th} - 8^{th}$ grade athletes from 37 Irvine elementary and middle schools, the dedicated support of 300 volunteers and an enthusiastic crowd of 2,000 spectators.

Following the challenges posed by the pandemic, the return of the Irvine Junior Games continues to support the ICF child care mission and plays a pivotal role in funding affordable and accessible child care programs before and after school and on school holidays year round at all 29 elementary schools in Irvine.

There is a national child care crisis, focusing on both access and affordability as child care remains a cornerstone for rebuilding the workforce and the economy. The lack of accessible and affordable child care adversely impacts businesses, tax revenue, and workforce stability. Irvine stands out by providing 3,000 child care spaces each day on elementary school campuses. However, affordability remains a challenge, especially for low-income working families who work hard but are in low paying jobs. ICF remains steadfast in its mission to support these families by providing child care scholarships, enabling them to access affordable child care services at their elementary schools, and providing stability to work.

The Irvine Strategic Plan for Children, Youth and Families addresses goals to ensure youth thrive emotionally, physically, academically and socially. ICF plays a vital role in our mission to provide child care scholarships to low-income working families, to provide funding to child care sites and to promote child wellness. ICF has raised \$4.1 million to provide these essential child care programs Irvine Unified School District benefiting working families.

> ICF cannot accomplish our child care mission alone and extends its gratitude to the generous donors who have consistently supported our efforts year after year. When corporations, foundations, community leaders, and individual donors come together as a community, we can work together to ensure a secure child care environment for working families.

the Irvine Children's Fund raise money for before and after school child care.



The Irvine Children's Fund is raising funds to meet the increased need for ICF Before and After School Child Care Scholarship Funds as child care continues to be an important key to rebuilding the workforce and the economy.

For 2023 – 2024, ICF has committed to raise \$375,00 to meet the school age child care scholarship needs of low income, working families.

The Irvine Junior Games (IJG) were conceived in 1986 with two objectives:

- First, the Irvine Junior Games serve as a fundraising event for the Irvine Children's Fund
- Second, to encourage the participation of elementary and middle school children in athletics and promote a healthy lifestyle

The Irvine Children's Fund (ICF) is a nonprofit organization in partnership with the Irvine Child Care Project with the purpose of raising money to:

- provide quality, affordable, safe & accessible before and after school child care for elementary school children
- provide child care scholarships for low-income, working families
- assist with funds to expand, maintain and enrich the 29 child care programs

Before & after school child care sites are now located on all 29 elementary school sites in the Irvine Unified School District



THE PREMIER CHILDREN'S ATHLETIC EVENT IN IRVINE 1,300 4th - 8th Grade Athletes Representing 37 IUSD schools

The Irvine Junior Games have evolved into a force for positive interaction that bring together parents, children, the Irvine Unified School District (IUSD), the City of Irvine, foundations and corporate & individual sponsors. The Irvine Junior Games are truly a unique celebration of the Irvine community.

All Irvine Unified School District students in 4th through 8th grade are invited to participate in the Irvine Junior Games track and field events. Each year we host



1,200 athletes participating in the 50 and 100 meter sprints, 400, 800 and 1500 meter long distance runs, school relays, the bag shot, soccer kick, basketball shoot, and the standing and running long jump. The Irvine Junior Games include events for children with special needs and children in adapted PE.

Each athlete receives an official T-shirt that includes sponsor recognition. Proceeds from athlete entry fees, spectators & concessions benefit ICF.

Festivities begin with a color guard leading off the parade of athletes marching in behind their school banners. The Opening Ceremony concludes with the national anthem & the lighting of the Irvine Junior Games flame.

Each year, the Irvine Junior Games are efficiently run thanks to the help of more than 300 VOLUNTEERS who plan and volunteer at the event.

More than 75 corporate & individual gold, silver, bronze and spirit team SPONSORS proudly support the Irvine Junior Games and generously contribute to help ICF reach our child care fundraising goal.

Thanks to our Irvine Junior Games sponsors, foundations & grants, the Irvine Children's Fund has raised \$4,135,498 to provide:

- \$3,328,125 to the Irvine Child Care Project for before and after school child care scholarships
- \$230,928 to the Irvine Child Care Project to expand and maintain the child care sites
- \$21,920 to complete the handicap accessibility at 7 child care sites
- 1,989 child care scholarships to low income, working families
- 72,128 child care days provided
- \$265,850 to the schools and teachers participating in the Irvine Junior Games
- \$288,675 to the before and after school child care sites for supplies and activities to enrich the programs for more 3,100 children
